#### 2021 Animal Health NOTE:

The Primary Equine Influenza and Tetanus vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all equines attending the Lincolnshire Horse & Pony Show. 'If sufficient time has elapsed' after the Primary two vaccinations, these should be followed by their six month and yearly vaccinations. No equines should enter competitions within 7 days of an El vaccination.

#### (This Rule may be subject to change from guidance from the FEI/BEF.

The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows: the first 2 vaccinations 21 - 92 days apart, a third booster between 150-215 days, and an annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter. No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an El vaccination. Foals should commence vaccinations at 6 months old.)

2. Horse of the Year Show Mountain & Moorland Working Hunter Pony Championship Qualifier 2021

The following class is a qualifier for the Mountain & Moorland Working Hunter Pony of the Year Championship, N.E.C., Birmingham, **6th - 10th October 2021**. This class is open to Mountain and Moorland stallions, mares and geldings, four years old and over, to be registered in, and complying with the showing requirements of, the main body of their respective stud books. Ponies must be within the correct height stipulations for their height section however ponies must not exceed the height limits as stipulated by the relevant breed societies. Riders of stallions must have obtained their 12th Birthday (small breeds) or 14<sup>th</sup> birthday (large breeds) before 1st January in the current year.

The highest placed pony not already qualified from the first three will qualify to compete at Horse of the Year Show 2021. Riders and Owners must be members of their respective Breed Society, NPS, Ponies (UK), The Showing Register or BSPS.

To be run under the rules of the Horse of the Year Show. Copies can be obtained from <u>www.hoys.co.uk</u> This is a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier, all data given upon entry of this class is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. For full policy details please visit www.grandstandentries.com. Judges may only judge one qualifying competition in the current year.

Marks to be awarded as follows:

- Phase 1 (70 Marks): Jumping points 50 marks, Style with jumping 20 marks
- Phase 2 (30 Marks): Breed, type & conformation 20 marks, Individual show & manners 10 marks

In the event of equality the total mark from the Jumping Phase will take precedence, followed by the Individual Show & Manners Mark, and then the Breed Type & Conformation Mark. Qualification will not pass below third place and will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show Office.

Mountain & Moorland Working Hunter ponies must jump a 12 fence track. Please note the fence height guidelines shown below which must be enforced for each section.

Qualification will not pass below third place and will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office.

Riders and Owners must be members of their respective Breed Society, NPS, UKPH, The Showing Register or BSPS.

b) TSR NAF Five Star Riders Championships - classes 152, 153, 154 and 155 are qualifiers for the 2021 TSR NAF Showing Finals. Riders can choose which Regional final they go to - Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, Wales and south West or Scottish. 1st & 2nd Riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

c) The British Show Pony Society will be awarding a rosette to the highest placed junior rider (under 18) in each height category of The British Show Pony Society Mountain & Moorland Working Hunter Pony of the Year qualifiers.

d) The B.S.P.S. Classic Services Group Challenge - All summer qualifying shows that are affiliated to the B.S.P.S. are qualifiers for the "The B.S.P.S. Challenge".
