- Make your payment by card: Do check your bank to confirm payment has been made.
- You'll receive a system response (this is not a record of Show Acceptance).
- **Show Acceptance** - you will receive a VAT Receipt from the Show Office via email.
- Your Passes will be sent out in the Post late May/early June.

Exhibitor Responsibility

Any Exhibitor, with a valid reason, wishing to withdraw an animal from a class or request a replacement animal in the same class needs to inform the Show office via email livestock@lincolnshireshowground.co.uk If the email is received either before or in the few days after the closing date for entries – this request will receive attention to determine the outcome either way.

After entries have closed and been catalogued Exhibitors are not entitled to a refund under any circumstances and no other new nominations or changes will be accepted.

OO Important Notes for ALL Livestock Exhibitors

Cancellation of Entries

The Lincolnshire Agricultural Society's Show Committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry / class / section, and will automatically cancel any section in which there are insufficient entries. All entry fees will be refunded in these circumstances.

Cancellation Statement

There may be circumstances where the show has to be postponed, cancelled, abandoned or curtailed as a result of circumstances beyond the control of the Society, for example as a result of a security alert or as a result of inclement weather making it impractical to hold the Show. In such circumstances once any administration fees have been deducted, entry fees will be refunded. The Society will have no liability for loss or damage suffered by exhibitors or others.

The EU Welfare of Animals in Transport Regulation (EC) No 1/2005.

All exhibitors must ensure that they comply fully with the current legislation issued by the Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs regarding the above Transport Regulation which came into force in January 2007 and are able to provide the appropriate documentation at the Show to the relevant governing authority.

For the purposes of this article, mammals shall not be considered fit for transport if they

- (a) are unfit animals (see DEFRA website Annex 1 Chapter 1 of Council Regulation 1/2005).
- (b) are pregnant female animals that have reached the latest stage of gestation (within 10% of the estimated time of the gestation before birth) and for a period of one week after giving birth.
- (c) are very young animals except if the journey is less than 100km, e.g. calves of less than 10 days of age, pigs less than 3 weeks of age and lambs of less than one week.
- (d) calves of less than 14 days of age on journeys exceeding 8 hours will not be permitted.

- that the animals described in the entries are free from clinical signs of disease. You further declare that you will take all due precautions to prevent the animal(s) from being exposed to infectious or contagious disease previous to the Show.
- that you have read, understand and undertake to abide by the REGULATIONS & INFORMATION and the Conditions specific to all classes entered, as published in the Livestock Prize Schedule. This includes the Tuberculosis declaration and Scrapie declaration for exhibitors of Cattle & Sheep.
