

**Lincolnshire Show: 22 & 23 June 2022
Tuberculosis in Cattle Declaration**

I can confirm that:

- a) The animals I intend to exhibit at the Lincolnshire Show on the **22 & 23 June 2022** have been TB tested according to the testing interval applicable to the county of their holding(s), stated on the entry.
- b) Where the county testing interval is 12-monthly, or where circumstances make it applicable (e.g. within a 3km radial testing area), the animals to be exhibited at the Lincolnshire Show have undergone a Pre-Movement TB Test as required under current DEFRA & APHA regulations and a copy of the results will accompany my animals to the show.
- c) There are no movement restrictions on the holding(s) that would preclude me from taking animals to the Lincolnshire Show.
- d) Any movements to the Lincolnshire Show comply with the conditions of the General Licence for the Movement of Cattle and six-day standstills will be adhered to.
(If cattle are attending multiple shows throughout the season, remember that standstill requirements also apply. Cattle returning home from a show will trigger a six-day standstill for all cattle on the holding.)
- e) I have taken and will continue to take all precautions to prevent the animals being exhibited at the Lincolnshire Show from being exposed to infectious, contagious or notifiable diseases and I undertake the sole liability for any consequences that may arise should intervention become necessary under Regulations imposed by orders of DEFRA & APHA /or any other relevant Health Scheme organisation.
- f) Should the TB status/testing interval of my holding(s) or county change, or movement restrictions be imposed on my holding(s) between completing this form and arrival at the Lincolnshire Show, I will contact the Lincolnshire Agricultural Society immediately.
