SHEEP ENTRIES will be accepted on the following basis:

- Advanced Entries close on **Wednesday 1 May 2024**. Any entries after this date to carry a premium of £1 per entry to FINAL Closing Date, **Wednesday 22 May**. Entries in all sections will be subject to limitations on availability of pens.
- Each animal may only be entered for one Sheep Class, however, this animal may then go into a Group Class, (entries for this must be made in advance of the Show). All entries are of course eligible for Special and Championship Classes which may be offered.
- A limited number of MV sheep pens 6' x 4' and Non-MV Sheep Pens 6' x 4' will be available at the Show and allocated on a first come, first served basis.
- Covered accommodation will be provided for all SHEEP. MV Accredited and Non-MV Accredited Scheme sheep will be housed in separate open sided marquees and have separate judging rings.

In the event of low exhibitor numbers in any of the breed classes or low entries catalogued, classes may be cancelled or amalgamated.
