The Lincolnshire Show Equine Information and Regulations

Exhibitors are required by DEFRA to carry with them Official Identity Documents for all horses/ponies when competing or travelling. Competitors are reminded that it is a DEFRA requirement that the Official Identity Documents must be in the name of the legal owner within 30 days of ownership. This must be registered with the breed society, relevant studbook or ID issuing agency, dependent on breed/type of animal. Spot checks may be carried out at qualifying shows and by breed societies.

Please also ensure that you are correctly registered with the appropriate Horse Society before making your entry. If you are unsure, please contact the society directly.

All equine health & welfare concerns are with the Veterinary Team, from the Rase Veterinary Centre, Market Rasen - available during the day on the Showground and on call at night.

2024 Animal Health NOTE:

The Primary Equine Influenza and Tetanus vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all equines attending the Lincolnshire Show. 'If sufficient time has elapsed' after the Primary two vaccinations, these should be followed by their six month and yearly vaccinations. No equines should enter competitions within 7 days of an EI vaccination.

(This Rule may be subject to change from guidance from the FEI/BEF.

The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows: the first 2 vaccinations 21 - 92 days apart, a third booster between 150-215 days, and an annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter.

No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an EI vaccination. Foals should commence vaccinations at 6 months old.)

Wristbands

Admission onto the Showground from the Horsebox Park will only be allowed for people wearing Equine Wristbands (inc. riders & their associates).

Extra Wristbands

If you require extra wristbands for your equine team/owners/riders you can purchase Additional Equine Wristbands at £20 each via our online entry system Showing Scene Pre-Show, (5 maximum per person). If you require more than 5 these can be purchased as Pre-Show Admission Tickets on www.lincolnshireshow.co.uk

PRIZE MONEY

Will be issued in the form of Prize Payment Cards; these can be redeemed at the showground on the day or posted to the showground for BACS payment after the show, more details will be on your prize payment card.

Cancellation Statement

There may be circumstances where the show must be postponed, cancelled, abandoned, or curtailed because of circumstances beyond the control of the Society, for example as a result of a security alert or as a result of inclement weather making it impractical to hold the Show. In such circumstances once any administration fees have been deducted, entry fees will be refunded, but the HOYS contribution is non-refundable. The Society will have no liability for loss or damage suffered by exhibitors or others.

Lincolnshire Show Regulations / Health Declaration (Equine)

Please note that by making entries into the Lincolnshire Show you are declaring:

- That the animals described in the entries are free from clinical signs of disease. You further declare that you will take all due precautions to prevent the animal(s) from being exposed to infectious or contagious disease previous to the Show.
- That you have read, understand and undertake to abide by the REGULATIONS & INFORMATION and the Conditions specific to all classes entered, as published in the Equine Prize Schedule.

The declaration is a tick box as you make your ONLINE Entry.

Wednesday 19 June 2024

Class SJ1 - The Lincolnshire Show Area Trial

(This Competition will be limited to 40 entries)

Rule 301. Table A10. Speed 375mpm. Start Height 1.50m.

DRAWN ORDER

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Qualifies for: National 1.40m Championship at the British Showjumping National Championships.

Qualifying period: 1st July - 30th June

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify to the final. Also, any two double clears from any International Trial or Area Trial or classes 1.40m or above in the qualifying period will qualify for the Final. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (e.g. Table A4 or Table A (1 Round)).

START TIME: SJ1 Programmed in the Main Ring for 12.20pm approx.

Class SJ2 - The Lincolnshire Show Accumulator

(This competition will be limited to 40 entries)

Rule 274. Table A. Speed 375mpm. Start Height 1.30m.

DRAWN ORDER

This competition takes place over six, eight or 10 obstacles which are progressively more difficult. No combination obstacles are allowed. The progressive difficulty is not solely due to the height and spread of the obstacles, but also to the difficulty of the track.

Points are awarded as follows:

One point for obstacle No. 1 cleared, two points for No. 2, three points for No. 3 etc. with total of 21, 36 or 55 points.

No point is awarded for an obstacle knocked down. Faults other than knockdowns are penalised as for Table A and any of these faults, including time faults, are converted into points and deducted from any jumping points scored.

In the event of equality of points for first place, there will be a jump-off against the clock over a shortened course, over obstacles that may be increased in height and/or spread. The obstacles in the jump-off must be jumped in the same order as in the first round and retain their respective points allotted in the first round.

This competition may also take place directly against the clock.

For the last obstacle of the course, an alternative obstacle may be provided, of which one part may be designated the Joker. The Joker must be more difficult than the alternative obstacle and carry double points. If the Joker is knocked down, the points must be deducted from the total.

(This competition will be limited to 40 entries)

Rule 306. Table A4. Speed 400mpm. Start Height 1.30m.

DRAWN ORDER

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate and Junior Members.

Qualifies for: The British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st July-30th June.

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify to the final. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (e.g. Table A4 or Table A (1 Round))

START TIME: SJ3 Programmed in the Main Ring for 09.00am approx.

PRIZES: 1st: £500.00, 2nd: £350.00, 3rd: £250.00, 4th: £150.00, 5th: £125.00, 6th: £75.00, 7th: £50.00

Class SJ4 - The Lincolnshire Show Grand Prix (National 1.40m Open)

Rule 301. Table A9. Speed 375mpm. Start Height 1.40m.

DRAWN ORDER

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Qualifies for: National 1.40m Championship at the British Showjumping National Championships.

Qualifying period: 1st July - 30th June

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify to the final. Also any two double clears from any International Trial or Area Trial or classes 1.40m or above in the qualifying period will qualify for the Final. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (e.g. Table A4 or Table A (1 Round))

START TIME: SJ4 Programmed in the Main Ring for 13.15pm approx.
